Petitioners, each being over eighteen (18) years of age and not under any disability, and each being entitled to receive summons as a party in the above action for dissolution of marriage, do hereby waive service of summons in accordance with Rule 4(D) of the Ohio Rules of Civil Procedure, and state that they each have received a copy of this Petition and voluntarily enter their appearance herein.
